What is the Copper Switch Off?

The 'copper switch off' is the replacement of the UK's copper landline infrastructure with fibre optic cable.

In December 2025, the ISDN (integrated service digital network) and PSTN (public switched telephone network) systems will be closed down for good.

This means your business will no longer be able to make and receive telephone calls through the current copper network.

Instead, phone calls will be facilitated digitally via the internet, using VoIP (Voice over Internet Protocol) technology.

This change will affect all businesses across the UK.
